LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

1. Out of Bounds

- 1.1 Beyond any fence bounding the course.
- 1.2 Beyond any line of white stakes with black tops.
- 1.3 Within the fences surrounding the tennis courts and within the building called the Tennis Pavilion (situated immediately to the left of the 1st Teeing Ground).
- 1.4 The Clubhouse gardens and on or beyond the associated Clubhouse pathways, unless otherwise marked as stated in 1.2.

2. Ground Under Repair

All areas defined by white stakes and/or lines.

3. Staked or Ornamental Trees

If a tree or a shrub which is staked interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player MUST take relief as provided in Rule 24-2b (i) (Immovable Obstructions).

4. Fixed Sprinkler Heads

The specimen Local Rule in Appendix I of the Rules of Golf applies.

5. Integral Parts of the Course

Unless otherwise marked, areas of the course treated with woodchip mulch are integral parts of the course. The woodchip and mulch are loose impediments.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

Match Play – Loss of Hole. Stroke Play – Two Strokes.
